

1. Feather and Fan Stitch

This stitch pattern is divisible by 18 stitches. That means any yarn and any size needle can be used. Determine the size you want by YOUR stitch gauge. Cast on any amount (divisible by 18 to achieve a width of 48 inches).

Work 10 rows of knit only at the beginning and ending of your piece.

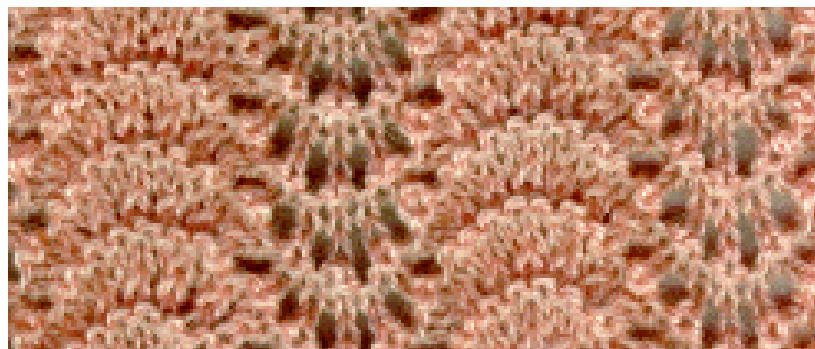
Row 1: K (right side)

Row 2: K 9, P to last 8 sts, K9

Row 3: K9, *K 2 tog 3 times, (YO, K1) 6 times, K 2 tog 3 times* repeat to last 9 sts K9.

Row 4: K

Work until length is approx 59 inches. End by working 10 rows Knit, cast off



Tasseled Trellises Afghan

Stitch this warm and easy-to-make afghan in colors to match your own decor. You'll want to make several to give as gifts to family and friends.

EXTRAVAGANZA

Experience Level

Beginner*

Finished Measurements

Approximately 48" x 60", excluding fringe

Materials

- Worsted weight yarn: 32 oz
- Size 8 (29") circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

- Crochet hook size H/8 (for fringe)

Gauge

16 sts = 4"/10cm in St st

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Pattern Stitch

Row 1 (WS): K2, p to within 2 sts of end, k2.

Row 2: K2, *p2, k2, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2, rep from * across to 4 sts from end, p2, k2.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

Afghan

CO 188 sts. Work 4 rows garter st, then work in patt until piece meas 60" or desired length. Work 4 rows garter st, BO in purl from RS.

Fringe (Optional)

Cut strands of yarn 10" long. Fold 4 strands in half and apply at 1" intervals across short ends of afghan. Weave in ends and block lightly. ❖



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Skill Level

Beginner

Finished Size

Approximately 52 x 66 inches

Materials

- Bulky weight yarn (143 yds/100g per ball): 16 balls light blue
- Size 10 (6mm) 29-inch circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

14 sts and 20 rows = 4 inches/10cm in pat
To save time, take time to check gauge.

Cast on 180 sts and work in garter st for 6 rows. Work pat as follows:

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Rows 2, 4 and 6: K5, p2, *[k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, rep from *, end k5.

Rows 3, 5 and 7: K8, *p1, k1, p1, k4, rep from *, end p1, k1, p1, k8.

Row 8: K5, p2, *k12, p2, rep from *, end k5.

Row 9: K7, *p12, k2, rep from *, end p12, k5.

Row 10: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Rows 11, 13 and 15: K7, *[p1, k1] twice, p1, k2, rep from *, end [p1, k1] twice, p1, k7.

Rows 12, 14 and 16: K5, p3, *k1, p1, k1, p4, rep from *, end k1, p1, k1, p3, k5.

Row 17: K5, p7, *k2, p12, rep from *, end k2, p7, k5.

Row 18: K12, *p2, k12, rep from * across.

Rep Rows 1–18 for pat until piece measures approximately 65 inches, ending with Row 8 or 16.

Knit 7 rows. Bind off all sts.

Finishing

Block lightly. ❖



Horseshoe Cable Afghan

Cuddle up a little closer in this lovely cable afghan.

EXTRAVAGANZA

Experience Level

Advanced beginner**

Size

Approximately 36" x 40"

Materials

- Worsted weight yarn (3½ oz per skein): 6 skeins
- Size 9 circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Size H/8 crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

16 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm in St st
To save time, take time to check gauge.

Special Abbreviations

Back cross (BC): Sl next 2 sts to cn, hold in back, k2, k2 from cn.

Front cross (FC): Sl next 2 sts to cn, hold in front, k2, k2 from cn.

Cable 8 back (C8B): Sl next 4 sts to cn, hold in back, k4, k4 from cn.

Cable 8 front (C8F): Sl next 4 sts to cn, hold in front, k4, k4 from cn.

Pattern Stitches

A. Double Moss Stitch (multiple of 4 sts)

Rows 1 & 2: *K2, p2, rep from * across.

Rows 3 & 4: *P2, k2, rep from * across.
Rep Rows 1–4 for patt.

B. Horseshoe Cable (panel of 36 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1, p2, k4, p2, [k8, p2] twice, k4, p2, k1.

Row 2 and rem WS rows: P1, k2, p4, k2, [p8, k2] twice, p4, k2, p1.

Row 3: K1, p2, FC, p2, [k8, p2] twice, BC, p2, k1.

Row 5: Rep Row 1.

Row 7: K1, p2, FC, p2, C8F, p2, C8B, p2, BC, p2, k1.

Row 9: Rep Row 1.

Row 11: Rep Row 3.

Row 13: Rep Row 1.

Row 15: Rep Row 7.

Rows 17–24: Rep Rows 1–4.
Rep Rows 1–24 for patt.

Afghan

CO 146 sts. Purl 1 row.

Set Up Patt

Row 1 (RS): K1, pM, work Patt A over 16 sts, pM, Patt B over 36 sts, pM, Patt A over 40 sts, pM, Patt B over 36 sts, pM, Patt A over 16 sts, pM, k1.

Row 2: K1, work Row 2 of Patts A and B as est, end k1.

Continue to work patt as est, k first and last st of every row until afghan meas approximately 40", ending with Row 24 of Patt B. Knit 1 row, BO in purl.

Finishing

With crochet hook, sc around entire afghan, working 3 sc in each corner. Weave in ends and block.

Fringe

Cut strands of yarn into 12" lengths. Fold 3 strands in half and pull through every 3rd or 4th sc on both ends of afghan. Trim fringe evenly. ♦

Approximately 42 x 58 inches (excluding fringe)

Materials

- Worsted weight acrylic yarn* (170 yds/3 oz per skein): 14 skeins off-white #3
- Size 13 (9mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

**Sample project was completed with Red Heart Classic (100 percent acrylic) from Coats & Clark.*

Gauge

7 sts = 3 inches/7.5cm in St st with 2 strands of yarn held tog

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Pattern Note

Project uses 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

Afghan

Cast on 97 sts.

Rows 1 and 2: *K2, p2, rep from * across, end k1.

Rows 3 and 4: *P2, k2, rep from * across, end p1.

Rows 5–8: Rep Rows 1–4.

Row 9: Rep Row 1.

Rows 10–12: Knit.

Rows 13–15: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Row 16 (RS): *P2, k6, rep from * across, end p1.

Row 17: K2, *p4, k4, rep from * across, end p4, k3.

Row 18: *K2, p2, rep from * across, end k1.

Row 19: P2, *k4, p4, rep from * across, end k4, p3.

Row 20: K4, *p2, k6, rep from * across, end p2, k3.

Row 21: K1, *p6, k2, rep from * across.

Row 22: P3, *k4, p4, rep from * across, end k4, p2.

Row 23: P1, *k2, p2, rep from * across.

Row 24: K3, *p4, k4, rep from * across, end p4, k2.

Row 25: P3, *k2, p6, rep from * across, end k2, p4.

Rows 26–30: Rep Rows 16–20.

Rows 31–34: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Rows 35 and 36: Knit.

Row 37: Purl.

Rows 38–41: K1, *p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 42: Knit.

Rows 43 and 44: Purl.

Rows 45–48: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Row 49: *P4, k2, rep from * across, end p1.

Row 50: K1, *p2, k4, rep from * across.

Rows 51 and 52: Rep Rows 49 and 50.

Row 53: P1, *k2, p4, rep from * across.

Row 54: *K4, p2, rep from * across, end k1.

Rows 55 and 56: Rep Rows 53 and 54.

Rows 57–60: Rep Rows 49–52.

Rows 61–64: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Rows 65–67: Knit.

Rows 68–71: Beg with a k row, work in St st.

Row 72: K1, *p4, k4, rep from * across.

Row 73: P3, *k4, p4, rep from * across, end p2.

Row 74: K3, *p4, k4, rep from * across, end p4, k2.

Row 75: P1, *k4, p4, rep from * across.

Row 76: *P4, k4, rep from * across, end p1.

Row 77: K2, *p4, k4, rep from * across, end p4, k3.

Row 78: P2, *k4, p4, rep from * across, end k4, p3.

Row 79: *K4, p4, rep from * across, end k1.

Rows 80–83: Beg with a k row, work in St st.

Rows 84–86: Purl.

Rows 87 and 88: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Row 89: *K1, p11, rep from * across, end k1.

Row 90: K1, p1, *k9, p1, k1, p1, rep from * across, end k9, p1, k1.

Row 91: K1, p1, k1, *p7, [k1, p1] twice, k1, rep from * across, end p7, k1, p1, k1.

Row 92: [K1, p1] twice, *k5, [p1, k1] 3 times, p1, rep from * across, end k5, [p1, k1] twice.

Row 93: P2, *k1, p1, k1, p3, rep from * across, end k1, p1, k1, p2.

Row 94: K3, *[p1, k1] 3 times, p1, k5, rep from * across, end [p1, k1] 3 times, p1, k3.

Row 95: P4, *[k1, p1] twice, k1, p7, rep from * across, end last rep p4 instead of k7.

Row 96: K5, *p1, k1, p1, k9, rep from * across, end p1, k1, p1, k5.

Row 97: Rep Row 95.

Row 98: Rep Row 94.

Row 99: Rep Row 93.

Row 100: Rep Row 92.

Row 101: Rep Row 91.

Row 102: Rep Row 90

Row 103: Rep Row 89.

Rows 104–106: Beg with a k row, work in St st.

Rows 107–128: Rep Rows 65–86.

Rows 129–148: Rep Rows 45–64.

Rows 149–158: Rep Rows 35–44.

Rows 159–163: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Rows 164–178: Rep Rows 16–30.

Rows 179–182: Beg with a p row, work in St st.

Rows 183 and 184: Knit.

Rows 185–193: Rep Rows 1–9.

Bind off all sts.

Fringe

Cut 14 (18-inch) strands for each fringe, fold in half, pull through st, pull ends through loop. Rep approximately every 2 inches across both ends of afghan. Trim even if needed. ♦



Trinity Stitch

Multiples of 4 (+ 16 sts for border edges)

Knit 8 rows

Row 1(RS): K8, P to last 8 sts, K8

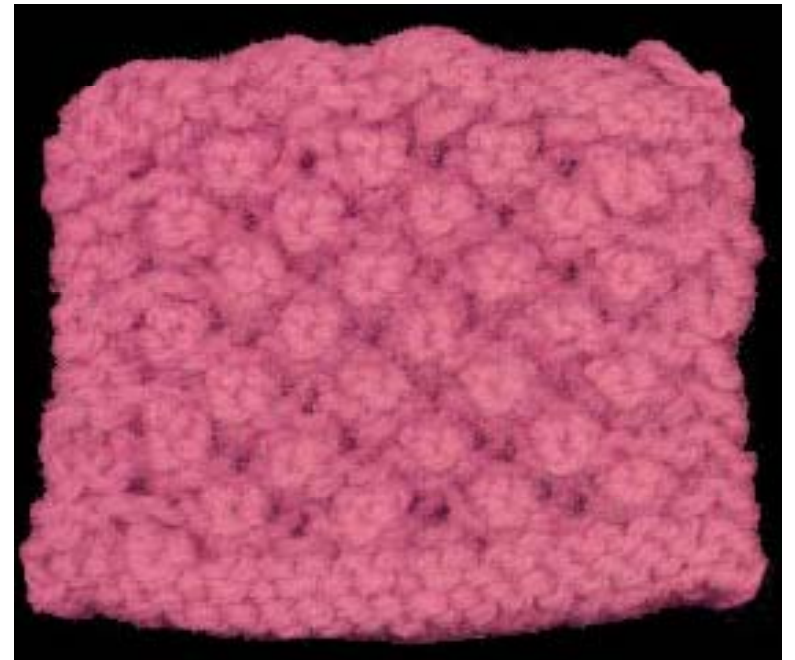
Row 2: K8 *k1, p1, k1 into next stitch, p3tog; rep from * to last 8 sts, K8

Row 3: K8, P to last 8 sts, K8

Row 4: K8 *p3tog, k1, p1, k1 into next stitch; rep from * to last 8 sts, K8

Continue until work measures about 59 inches – K8 rows and cast off

Add fringing to edges if desired



Flame Stitch Afghan Knitting Pattern

Designed by Barbara Breiter

This is an easy afghan pattern. You could use three patriotic colors such as red white and blue, repeating the simple Flame Stitch pattern. The pattern stitch results in a subtle fluting effect that adds to the beauty of this afghan.

Size: Approx 40" wide and 60" long

Gauge: 14 sts = 4" in pattern stitch with two strands held together

Materials:

Size 10½ US (6.5 mm) 36" circular needles

Caron Simply Soft (or appropriate substitution 100% acrylic yarn - 6 ounces/330 yards)

6 skeins (Color B - white)

4 skeins (Color A - red)

2 skeins (Color C – dark blue or navy)

Instructions

Pattern Stitch (Flame Stitch - Multiple of 4 + 1)

Cast on with Color A (red) and purl one row.

Row 1 (RS): k1, *sl 3 wyib, k1* rep from *

Row 2: P2, *sl 1 wyif, p3* rep from *, end sl 1 p2

Row 3: knit

Row 4: purl

Rep these 4 rows.



Note: Afghan color sequence: Work 4 rows of Pattern Stitch with Color **A** (red), **B** (white), **A** (red), **B** (white), **C** (blue), **B** (white)

With color **A**, cast on 155 sts and work in Pattern Stitch, slipping the first st and knitting the last st of every row. Cont until 60 inches or desired length and cast off.

If desired work one round of single crochet around edge with Color **B**. You can add fringing if desired.

Star Stitch Afghan

Multiple of 4 + 1

Cast on sufficient sts to measure approximately 40 inches width

Row 1: (right side) Knit

Row 2: P1, *MS, P1; repeat from * to end

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: P3, MS, *P1, MS; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

Continue until work measures about 60 inches, cast off.

MS = Purl 3 sts together leaving sts on the left hand needle. Wrap yarn around the needle then purl the same 3 sts together again.



TLC® "Heathers": 20 Ounces No. 2465 Lichen CA, 6 1/2 ounces each No. 2441 Oatmeal CB, No. 2452 Mulberry CC, No. 2495 Port Wine CD, and No. 2455 Purple Haze CE

Circular Knitting Needle: 10mm [US 15] – 29" sizes

Throw measures approximately 48" x 60".gauge/tension

TLC® "Heathers": 20 Ounces No. 2465 Lichen CA, 6 1/2 ounces each No. 2441 Oatmeal CB, No. 2452 Mulberry CC, No. 2495 Port Wine CD, and No. 2455 Purple Haze CE

Circular Knitting Needle: 10mm [US 15] – 29" sizes

Throw measures approximately 48" x 60". gauge/tension

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4"; 29 rows = 10" in Stockinette stitch with double strand.

CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge

Instructions

With **CA**, cast on 114 sts and K 6 rows.

*With **CB**, K 2 rows, then [K 1 row, P 1 row] twice.

With **CC**, K 2 rows, then [K 1 row, P 1 row] twice.

With **CD**, K 2 rows, then [K 1 row, P 1 row] twice.

With **CE**, K 2 rows, then [K 1 row, P 1 row] twice. ***

With **CA**, K 2 rows, then [K 1 row, P 1 row] 5 times. **

Rep from * to ** 4 **more** times, then from * to *** once more. Change to **CA** and K 7 rows. Bind off in K.

Side Edging: With right side facing and **CA**, pick up and K149 sts along a side edge. K 6 rows. Bind off in K. Rep on opposite side of throw. Weave in ends.
